

Preparing Your Home for Fumigation
CHECKLIST

(TO BE CHECK OFF AS YOU PREPARE FOR YOUR FUMIGATION)

- If you **Do Not** plan to meet the crew,
 PLEASE MAKE KEY ARRANGEMENTS WITH THE FUMIGATION COMPANY.
State Regulations require that we have a key in our possession at all times during the fumigation and access to ALL locked areas.
- **Remove the Following:**
 - People**
 - Pets:** Dogs, Cats, Birds, Aquariums. (Do not allow pets to be left or roam in yard)
 - Plants** located within the home/building, patios, porches, balconies, being fumigated that you wish to not have damaged.
 - Baby Mattresses;** enveloped with plastic
 - Plastic Covers** covering mattresses or sofa furniture
 - Articles of Value:** jewelry, money, silver, art pieces, collectibles, any articles of value to you should be removed.
- **Remove or Double Bag in Nylofume or Master Fume Bags food & medicines NOT in original glass, metal or plastic containers with manufacture's original seal.**
Food in Kitchen Examples:
Dry foods in cardboard containers, candy, Open liquor, wine, fruits, veggies, meats, frozen foods, dairy products, and anything that has already been opened and that is edible, etc...
 - Food in Fridge** **Food in Cabinets/Pantries** **Medicine In Bathrooms/Rooms**
 - Oxygen Peroxide, Toothpaste/ Mouthwash** **Food Stored In Garage** **Pet Food**
- All Vehicles, Boats, Trailers, Campers, in garage must be unlocked during the fumigation for aeration purposes. Vehicles must also have Windows rolled down and have trunks left open.
- Contact Your Gas Company to **schedule gas TURN-ON the third day of your fumigation anytime after 12pm.**

Exterior Preparation

- Cut back and/or trim all plants and trees around the perimeter of the home/building, approximately 1-2 feet away from the wall. **Any climbing plants on walls must be removed.**
- Any gravel or decorative bark must be pulled back approximately 1-2 feet away from the wall in order to achieve proper ground seal.
- Wet down the soil along the foundation of the building, the added moisture allows for an improved ground seal and helps protect any plant root systems nearby.
- Remove any antennas mounted to the structure. In some cases we are able to work around them depending on location and size of antenna(s), but if we are forced to remove them with caution due to tarping procedures we will assume no responsibility for any damage or alignment adjustments.
- Turn Off automatic sprinkler systems
- Turn Off exterior lights on timers
- Turn Off burglar or movement alarms
- Notify your Neighbors of scheduled fumigation dates. **If Fumigation crew must access your neighbors property make sure you have attained a neighbors release form and signature on the back side of your Occupants Notice.**

******Side Notes******

- Electricity must be made available throughout the fumigation process. However gas will be shut off.
- Caution will be used when working around plants surrounding the property but cannot be held responsible to entirely save all plants in the areas nearest to the structure(s) being fumigated.
- Caution will be used when working on the roof, due to the nature of the service there is the potential for minor damages that we cannot be held responsible for.
- We are not held responsible for antennas and satellite dishes mounted on your roofs. By all means we will perform our service with care but be aware that there is the potential for misalignments of antennas mounted on roofs for which we hold NO responsibility.
- When you return to your home after it's been cleared for re-occupancy. There is no need for you to wash dishes, clothes, or any other articles left within the structure because there should be no residue from the fumigation.

Please take the time to read the back side of Your Fumiation Documents for further preparation instructions and important information regarding the fumigation of your home/ building.
